Replacing sex with gender is problematic because it introduces legal uncertainty, undermining important sex-based rights. It also eliminates protections based on biological reality, which is unacceptable in a society that values fairness and equity.

The reforms risk freedom of religion due to their broad nature, as they may not adequately protect religious beliefs if religion is not precisely defined, potentially leading to infringement on religious practices and rights.

A subjective approach towards vilification is inappropriate because it relies on individual's perceptions and may vary widely, potentially leading to misuse and infringement on free speech rights. This approach is not balanced by any significant benefits and lacks objective criteria, making it unjustifiable.
