The following seem to me to be the most serious things for you to think about:

- Replacing sex with gender is problematic because it eliminates protections based on biological reality and introduces legal uncertainty, which undermines important sex-based rights. As a result, it may lead to difficulties in enforcing certain laws and policies, and could potentially have negative consequences for individuals who rely on these protections for their well-being and safety.
- As a believer, I am deeply concerned that the broad nature of these reforms poses a risk to freedom of religion. If religion isn't defined and protected properly, our beliefs and practices may face restrictions or even persecution. We must ensure that our faith and religious expressions remain safeguarded in these complex times.
