Subject: ADA SUBMISSION
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I've been doing home based sex work in my Sydney public housing rental for 9 years. But housing NSW specifically prohibits sex work being done at the properties.

This discrimination puts me, a vulnerable person, at risk of eviction and homelessness, even though my work is legal and I'm a model tenant.

Councils are allowed to discriminate against me by prohibiting sex work from my home. This puts my livelihood at risk, despite the work being legal.

I'm afraid to come out to my NDIS support workers due to discrimination. This limits my NDIS support usefulness in all areas, including occupational therapy, counselling and in home support.

I'm afraid to disclose that I'm a sex worker to my bank due to banks shutting down sex worker's bank accounts and refusing to provide a bank account to sex workers.

People, including professional service providers can legally out me as a sex worker to government departments, private companies and family members which can create crisis for me.
